Your role:

PNC is looking for a Vice President, Security and Standardisation. In this role you will be responsible to follow and give input to a wide range of cards related security and standardization activities on behalf of PNC members. The activities can be both on country, region, European and Global level.

Key tasks include:

- Represent PNC members in card related security and standardization forums
- Review and give input to cards related standards, independently and in cooperation with PNC member representatives
- Liaise with various actors of the card payment industry (e.g. card schemes) to promote standardisation solutions which are beneficial and meets the requirements of PNC members and the needs of the Nordic region.
- Interact with members to ensure their opinions are reflected in PNC positions regarding standards and specifications, ensure member influence is maximised and that knowledge is shared
- Provide regular reporting to members and internally about card standardization activities
- Run and/or participate in PNC standardization related committees and forums

Travelling is a natural part of this role and you should therefore expect to spend some of your working time away from the office. You may also need to participate in some Web and phone meetings outside of regular office hours.

Essential competencies:

- Extensive experience from working in the payment card industry and its eco system
- In depth knowledge of technical standards for cards, e.g. nexo, ECSG The Volume, EBA, ISO/CEN, PCI SSC, EMVCo and Schemes and how these standards relate to each other in the cards eco system
- Experience with standards development and maintenance
- Experience with negotiating and influencing parties in a multi-national, multi-lingual and multi-cultural environment
- Understand the technical impact of various standardisation initiatives on the business of PNC members
- Excellent command of the English language together with one or more Scandinavian language
- Excellent writing and presentation skills
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision

- Knowledge of French and/or German language
- Work experience from multiple sectors of the card business, e.g. scheme, processor, merchant, acquirer, issuer
